Welcome to ThinPATH Plus V3

ThinPATH Plus V3™ is a multi-user Windows software product that extends the capabilities for PCs, ThinPATH PCs, and thin clients in environments deploying Microsoft Windows Terminal Services. ThinPATH Plus V3 is specifically designed to fully support Windows 2003 SP1/R2 Releases.

ThinPATH Plus Version 2.11 is still available and fully supports older Windows Terminal Services environments, i.e. Windows 2000 Server and Windows NT 4.0 Terminal Server Edition. For full details on ThinPATH Plus Version 2.11, see the ThinPATH Plus Version 2.11 documentation at www.tp-sys.com.

ThinPATH Plus V3 Licensing Requirements

ThinPATH Plus Licensing model requires each user that connects to Microsoft Terminal Servers using ThinPATH Plus virtual port mapping software will require a individual license. These licenses are installed only on the PC running Microsoft Terminal Services. This license does not include support for concurrent licensing. Any client devices that are using ThinPATH Plus virtual port mapping software will require a license.

The ThinPATH Plus License prefix is **1226**. The license prefix is the first 4 numbers of the license, i.e. **1226-7001246-000001-XXXXX**. The second number, **7001245** in the example above is the serial number. The third number, **000001** is the license count. The license count must be higher than the total number of users using the ThinPATH Plus virtual port mapping software.

Upgrading ThinPATH Plus Licenses

The ThinPATH software license number supporting Version 2 of ThinPATH Plus will not be valid with ThinPATH Plus Version 3. ThinPATH Plus Version 3 requires a new license. A ThinPATH Plus Version 2 license can be identified by a license prefix of **0226** and a ThinPATH Plus Version 3 license uses a **1226** prefix.

Upgrading ThinPATH Plus from V2.11 to V3

When upgrading from ThinPATH Plus Version 2.11 or older to ThinPATH Plus Version 3 will first require removal of all older version on the server. From Add/Remove programs on the Microsoft Windows Terminal Services PC remove all older versions of ThinPATH Plus prior to installing Version 3.
